    margin: 0;
padding: 2px 0 2px 16px;
    list-style: none;}

<ul class="list-cleaned">
  <li>First list item</li>
  <li>Second list item</li>
  <li>Third list item</li>
</ul>
```

### Output:

First list item  
Second list item  
Third list item

I think it looks a bit cleaner than bullet points.
